### **Ziv Medical Center**

Ziv Medical Center, a general hospital in the north of Israel, located in Zefat, serves the Upper Galilee and northern Golan Heights. Ziv's multiethnic patients and staff come from towns and villages in the northern periphery. The hospital, in its current location, opened its doors in 1973 and has grown steadily over the years.

Ziv's comprehensive services now include 331 in-patient beds, laboratories and imaging facilities, out-patient clinics, a regional trauma unit, a new Child Health Center, mental health services for adults and children, a nursing school and a research center. A radiotherapy Institute was opened in June 2017, and the PET-CT Unit will be inaugurated in April 2018. Ziv Medical Center is an academic and research center, affiliated with the Bar-Ilan University Faculty of Medicine which opened in Zefat in 2011. This academic affiliation serves to strengthen Ziv's role in training physicians and increasing research capacity, while it has brought high quality medical and academic professionals to take senior positions in the hospital. In June 2017, Ziv Medical Center received accreditation from the Joint Commission International Standards for Hospitals. Ziv is committed to providing high quality care to the population at all times.

Ziv Medical Center is situated in close proximity to Israel's borders with Syria (aerial distance 30 km/19 miles) and Lebanon (aerial distance 11 km/7miles). Ziv has provided complex hospital services to over 1500 civilians injured in the war in Syria over the last several years as humanitarian aid.

### **Emergency Needs**

Following the recent developments in the Middle East, Ziv Medical Center currently finds itself in a state of preparedness for emergency.

Due to planning in the past for conflict preparedness, and the threat of direct missile fire, Ziv Medical Center now has the capacity to transfer many of its patients who cannot be discharged home to safe facilities. These patients are, mainly premature babies, mothers in stages of childbirth and newborn, children and other vulnerable patients to an advanced under-ground reinforced area. This reinforced area has the required beds but still lacks some crucial medical equipment.

The hospital's staff continues to provide regular and emergency services to the fullest capacity possible. Besides treating patients in the underground facility, Ziv has the additional task of trauma care in the reinforced Emergency Room for civilians injured by a range of missiles and wounded soldiers evacuated from combat areas.

In order to provide the wounded with life-saving treatment while at the same time providing patients and injured with the best possible medical care, Ziv Medical Center is in great need of assistance to purchase the following:
